Effort marks are graded from 1(top) to 5 (bottom). “3” is the normal mark, and will apply to the vast majority of the children. A “1” will have been agreed personally by the Headmaster, Deputy Head or Director of Studies.

1. Exceptional effort, both inside and outside the classroom.
2. Always works to the best of her ability.
3. Generally works to the best of her ability.
4. Does not always make sufficient effort.
5. Is causing concern as she rarely makes sufficient effort.

Attainment marks are given as a percentage, along with the class average percentage (stating if applicable whether the average is for the year, set or form). Performance marks are a mixture of preps, exams and lesson work. For some subjects the National Curriculum level at which the child is assessed by her teacher to be working may be given. In particular Maths, Science and English will include NC levels in the Summer Term reports for Years 7, 8 and 9.
