

## DRESS CODE

### Summer

Year 7 and up: Uniform *skirt* and white short-sleeved shirt or white school *aertex*. Uniform *blue jumper* may be worn on top. Short white socks. Black or navy blue shoes with sensible heels.

Year 6 and below: Uniform *dress* with belt. Uniform *blue cardigan* may be worn on top. Short white socks. Black or navy blue shoes with sensible heels.

### Winter

Year 7 and up: Uniform *kilt*, white long-sleeved shirt, uniform *green jersey* (or , for the Chapel Choir in S3, *green Choir sweat shirts*) may be worn on top, dark brown tights or socks, black or brown shoes with sensible heels.

Year 6 and below: Uniform *kilt*, white long-sleeved shirt, uniform *beige jersey* may be worn on top, beige tights or knee socks, black or brown shoes with sensible heels.

### Coats

Year 7 and up: *Team jacket*. S3 may wear a smart black mid-calf length coat.

Year 6 and below: *Navy blue jacket*.

### Hats and scarves

School *hats* and *scarves* may be worn.

Summer uniform is worn during the Summer Term. Children may continue to wear Summer uniform until the first Autumn Leave Out if they wish.

Uniform is to be worn for all public occasions, both outside and inside the school, including concerts, debates and plays, unless other dress is allowed.

All dress to be tidy and smart. Long hair should be tied back with a plain dark-coloured band or tie. *Games clothes* may be worn in lessons only with the permission of the teacher giving the lesson.

No make up or nail varnish. One pair of plain silver or gold studs may be worn in the earlobes (S3 may wear plain pearl studs). A simple crucifix may be worn as a necklace. No bracelets, rings or other jewellery.

Teachers have discretion to ask a child to dress more suitably, or to ask a child to remove and hand in for safe keeping any jewellery which they believe to be excessive. Their judgement takes priority over any written rule.

**Note:** *Items in italics must be bought from the school shop.* Some other items (shirts and tights) may be bought from the school shop.
