Everything sent to school must be clearly named with sewn on nametapes.

Jewellery: Girls in school uniform must restrict their jewellery to a small cross and chain, a pair of gold or silver stud earrings worn traditionally with one in each ear lobe and a wristwatch.

Hair: hairstyles should be simple: long hair must be tied back with black, dark green or brown ribbons. Artificial colour, if used, must be extremely discreet.

School will supply girls with a Good News Bible with Apocrypha and Hymn Book. Girls to provide their own pens, pencils and pencil case and a black school bag.

Additional items for boarders

1 pair wellingtons and welly socks
1 small (day) rucksack
2 bath towels
1 pair bedroom slippers
1 linen bag
1 brush and comb
1 hairwash towel with loop
1 single duvet
2 duvet covers
1 or 2 pillows
2 or 4 pillow cases
2 night-dresses/pyjamas
dressing gown
3 doz. extra name tapes for Boarding Assistants
tuck box with lock (optional)
waterproof jacket for weekend walks
heavy shoes for weekend walks
1 water bottle (highly desirable).

Often girls are unsure what they will need to wear at the weekends at Queen Marys.

This is a guide to the type of clothes they will need to pack, but please remember that all home clothes must be clearly named, so that we can minimise the loss of their personal items.

At the most the girls may be here for 3 weekends in a row but this will only be a couple of times a year.

It is more common that they have 2 weekends boarding before they go home again. With that in mind they only need limited amount of home clothes.

Guide list for home clothes

2	Pairs of jeans
1	Skirt / casual dress – optional
4	Tops
2	Jumpers
1	Cardigan – optional
1	Pair of wellies and wellie socks
	Woolly hat, scarf and gloves (autumn and spring term only)
2	Pairs tights/home socks/leggings
1	Set of clothing that they do not mind getting dirty
1	Set of smart casual for trips to cinema etc
1	Pair of trainers
1	Pair of day shoes

Please also take into account that girls have limited storage facilities in the Dormitories, which also has to accommodate their school uniform and bed linen.
