Dear Parents,

In November last year I sent a letter to parents regarding girls bringing over the counter medication into school. This week alone we have had a strip containing Nurofen Express liquid capsules found on a locker room floor and a bottle of Nurofen Liquid found on a mini bus.

This makes it very difficult to monitor what the girls are taking and more worrying is the safety issue. Medicines like paracetamol are very effective at managing pain but they can also be very dangerous if the recommended dose is exceeded.

I keep a stock of paracetamol, Ibuprofen; Lemsips etc in the day room so there should be no need for girls to bring in their own supply and would discourage them from doing so. If your daughters is taking any prescribed medication that needs to be taken during normal school hours then this to should be brought to the day room.
