Year 5 Geography fieldtrip to Teesmouth Field Centre

As part of the Key Stage Two Geography syllabus, pupils are required to study an area within the UK, which contrasts with their own locality. On Tuesday 25th May I am planning to take Year 5 to Teesmouth Field Centre, situated in the industrial heart of Teesside. They will learn about the river, the industry, environmental change and conservation in the area.

The girls will need to be suitably equipped with Wellington boots, waterproof coats or anoraks and should also wear a sweater on top of a blouse or T-shirt. They should also bring trainers or shoes to wear when inside the Field Centre.

School will provide a packed lunch and there will be no need for pocket money. We will depart during registration and return in time for the end of afternoon school. The girls will be supervised at all times by experienced Field Centre Staff, Mrs Sheppard and myself.

On this date there is also a **Rounders** match organised to play away at Red House Prep School, Norton for the **Under 10 team**. The plan of action is for Mrs Sheppard to return in one mini-bus to school in time for 4.00pm and for myself to take the team onto Red House and meet up with Mrs Lindsley and the Under 11 team to play their fixture. If your daughter is selected for the team she will need to arrange a late pick-up or to board. She will also need to make sure that she has her PE kit and trainers with her.
