

## **Stable Safety**

If a member of year 3 – 6 wishes to go to the stables during the day they must first obtain permission from a member of the KS2 staff and be in a group of at least 3.

If a member of the senior school (years 7-11) wishes to go to the stables during the day they should sign in and out at the office.

Although there are riding staff at the stables, they are not responsible for children who are watching lessons or visiting friends. They will, of course, assist in any emergency that may occur. It is the responsibility of each child to behave accordingly or their privilege of visiting the stables may be removed.

When any pupil goes to the stables after school they must wear a fluorescent jacket (located by the back door and at the stables) both to and from the stables. It should be written in the register if a pupil is to go to the stables at this time or they must sign out with the office (until 5pm) or with a duty member of staff (after 5pm). When they return back to school they should sign back in with the duty staff (unless after 8pm then should sign in with a member of the boarding team).

It is expected that all girls who are riding after day light hours, away from the lit arena, should wear reflective fluorescent jackets at all times.

In the event of a fire alarm at the main school a member of the administrative staff will phone the stables to ensure all children are accounted for.
