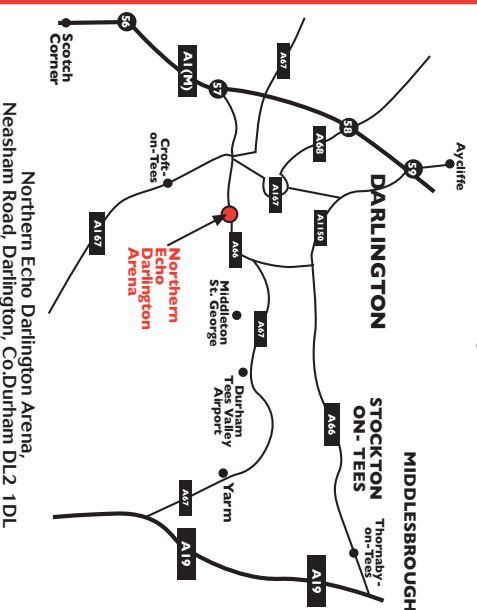
CHARITIES



DISC (Young Carers Project) works with young people aged 5 – 18 whose lives are in some way restricted because of the need to take responsibility for the care of a person who is experiencing physical or mental health problems, has a disability, is affected by alcohol, substance use or has a terminal or chronic illness. Our aim is to support, help and advise young carers by offering one to one work, support groups, respite, advice, training and family work.

Weardale Community Hospital is based in Stanhope with our main focus of care being Palliative and Rehabilitation. We also work in partnership with the Butterwick Hospice to provide a Day Hospice each week, enabling patients to remain at home for as long as possible and allowing their carers some respite time. We also provide outpatient clinics re podiatry, physiotherapy, lymph oedema, orthopaedics and multiple sclerosis.

Alzheimer's Society provides information & support for people with dementia & their carers, campaigns for their rights, and funds research to one day defeat dementia. 1 in 3 people over 65 will die with dementia. Dementia is not a natural part of ageing, it's caused by diseases of the brain that devastate lives. alzheimers.org.uk
