Vaccination against Influenza

Once again we have had a poor response to the Influenza vaccination. Dr Rajan and I would like to stress the importance of this vaccination especially to girls with Asthma and other ongoing medical conditions. Boarders are also at an increased risk due to living in close proximity to other girls. It is a very safe and well tolerated vaccination which offers protection against Seasonal Flu. This year we have the additional concerns of the possible effects that Swine Flu could have within the school environment.

Day girls may have the vaccination at a cost of £13.00; there will be no charge for weekly and full boarders.

If you would like your child to receive the vaccination please sign and return the consent form below. Alternatively you can reply via email to beas@queenmarys.org. Consent must be returned by Friday 9th of October. We plan to give the vaccinations on Wednesday 14th of October.

Children 12 and under who have not been previously vaccinated will need a repeat dose after 4 weeks.
