### World Book Day

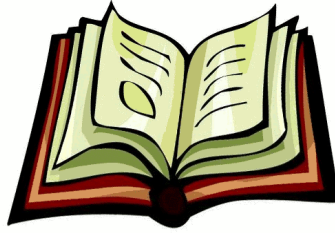
**Thursday 1st March** will be World Book Day and so the girls are invited to come dressed as their favourite book character.

They can either write their own poem or find a published poem to recite. They must learn the poem by heart and they can add actions or props if appropriate. If the girls are writing their own poem they may need a little help, however it is important that the poem is one they have written mostly on their own!
